MRI OF THE BRAIN - (03/17/11 compared with 09/16/10)

---

The follow-up study again shows a heterogeneously enhancing lesion involving the pineal gland, representing the patient's known neoplasm. It has slightly decreased in size as well as intensity of enhancement when compared with the previous study. It is difficult to determine the measurement accurately due to the irregular borders of the enhancement. No new abnormal enhancement or signal is present. Stable, chronic hemorrhagic changes are present in the right frontal lobe.

Also provided are images of the MRI of the spine which do not show any abnormal enhancement or signal to suggest the presence of any metastatic disease.

The following measurements are expressed in centimeters:

T1 AXIAL: ENHANCED

Pineal bed enhancement            2.0 x 1.5 = 3.0 (20% decrease since previous)

IMPRESSION: There is slight decrease in the size and intensity of enhancement of the pineal gland tumor.

T: SRB/rf
